

**Position:** Fundraising Intern

Fundraising is a vital part of any non-profit organization. In-Sight Collaborative relies heavily on crowd funding to support our projects and we use various strategies to bring that funding in. Ethical fundraising campaigns that preserve the privacy and dignity of those affected by forced displacement is one of our top priorities. We strongly oppose campaigns that exploit people's vulnerability or perpetuate power dynamics between contributors to campaigns and those receiving support.

The accompaniment model promotes an attitude of collaboration and horizontal support versus top-town or even bottom-up approaches. We apply this model to all of our interventions, including fundraising. This internship position will teach the participant about an entirely new method of generating funds and support. The intern will play a direct role in strategy development for campaigns and will work with the entire In-Sight Collaborative team and staff.

Upon successful completion of the internship, all interns will receive a letter of recommendation from In-Sight Collaborative president Madi Williamson and will be able to include all projects, campaigns, and material that they contributed to or created in their professional portfolios. These internships are designed to be part-time and done in tandem with work, school, and other life commitments. Our team at In-Sight is flexible, we only ask for consistency and adherence to the schedule that is relevant to your internship position.
