



The Need

Kinder World Community Partnerships was established in Lebanon to provide holistic support for a settlement of Syrian refugees in the north of the country near the city of Tripoli. Kinder World is a project that aims to create a sustainable support model for families seeking refuge through community partnership and solidarity.

Through the creation of a dedicated network, we will directly address the needs identified by camp residents and assist with solutions that empower the community.

Projects may grow to include telemedicine services, medical and dental care, psychosocial support, nutrition, sustainable farming, education, language skills, parenting support, childcare, individual skill-building, team development through athletics, winterization, and access to clean water.

Shared Goals of the Project

- Long-lasting support of the affected communities
- Community-directed interventions in partnership with donors
- The implementation of interventions that address the short and long-term needs of the affected population

Project Impact

- Winterization of a settlement of 155 people including shelter repair, warm coats, and oil for heaters by Kinder World Minnesota
- A new settlement of 134 people was taken on by Kinder World California
- Both settlements were supplied with bread and dates for the start of Ramadan
- Both settlements were equipped with cleaning supplies and educational material in response to COVID-19 (pictured)
